Details Parents Need To Know:

The Service Project

- Drop off is at the student's normal drop off time on Friday, April 23, 2010.
- Daily uniforms should be worn.
- Students will be assembling meals with their class and will be supervised by their classroom teacher.
- Classes have been assigned a time to assemble the meals so that the gymnasium does not become overcrowded and so that we can meet our goal of 125,000 meals!

Pledges

Money raised by the students in grades k-8 goes toward the CCS Capital Campaign. Pledges for students in grades 9-11 count as credits toward their individual Senior Service Practicum expenses. After 3 years of participation in the student fundraiser, they are sure to have accumulated considerable credits. Money raised by the students in grade 12 goes toward the Senior Service Practicum general fund.

- We are asking each CCS student to target a goal of \$100 in pledges. This goal may be higher for high school students accumulating credits for their Senior Service Practicum.

- If students need additional pledge forms or donor receipt cards, these items may be printed from the website or picked up at the school office.
- Pledge forms and money may be turned in from now until April 23. The final deadline is Friday, April 23, 2010, at 9:00 a.m. Students turning in pledge money and forms after 9:00 a.m. on Friday, April 23, will not be eligible for the special prize.
- If you are submitting your pledges using the printed form (not online), please review and follow the instructions on the pledge sheet.
- Matching gifts from companies are welcome! Whether the donation being matched is submitted online or through the traditional method, a corporate match form must be completed by the employee and turned in with the student's pledge form to receive prize credit for the matching gift.
- Please convey to your child the kindness of providing a thank-you card for donations they receive. CCS will give a receipt for donations of \$20 or more.

Prizes

- Students raising \$225 or more will receive a customized CCS long sleeved T-shirt.
- There is a class competition in each hallway at CCS. The class in each hallway (grades k-8) which collects the highest amount of pledge money will receive a fun lunch party compliments of the CCS development Office.
