



PSAT/NMSQ FAQ'S

What is the cost of the test?	The cost of the test has been incorporated in the fees and tuition.
When should I arrive?	Students must arrive by 8:00 AM. Anyone arriving after 8:00 AM may not be admitted to the exam.
How long is the Digital Adaptive Test?	Students should be finished with the exam between 11:45 am and 12:15 pm. depending on the test administration.
What to bring?	A charged laptop.
What about cellphones, smart watches, and calculators?	Students may not bring cellphones and smart watches into the testing room. They must leave those items in their lockers or their cars. Students may only use approved calculators. Click here PSAT/NMSQT Calculator Policy - SAT Suite College Board to access the approved calculators through College Board.
Do I wear my CCS uniform?	Yes
When are the results available?	Historically, results for the PSAT/NMSQT will be available in December.
May Freshmen take this test?	All Freshmen will take a Digital Adaptive Practice PSAT in school to get familiar with the digital format.
