## Semester 1: Monday/Wednesday

| Fine Arts | Art: Foundations | $6^{\text {th }}$ grade students only. Artwork focuses on foundational art skills and learning the Elements and Principles of art and how to write about their artwork. | Fine Arts: Music | Fundamentals of Music | Students from musical or non-musical backgrounds gain the knowledge necessary to achieve a higher level of musicianship skills. The topics and skills that will be covered and put into practice include reading pitches, naming notes, counting rhythms, identifying keys and scales, building chords and chord progressions as well as basic ear training skills. By analyzing famous performances, musical scores and practicing aural skills, the musical elements will come to life in a tangible way.
