

**AFTER-SCHOOL CARE PROGRAM
CARY CHRISTIAN SCHOOL

In order to keep our students safe, all CCS K-8 students must be supervised by a parent or CCS staff member while anywhere (e.g. classrooms, hallways, lobby, common area, playgrounds, athletic fields) on campus on school days from 7:30 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. All students not picked up during their designated carpool time (see Parent Student Handbook) must go to the After-School Care Program.

AFTER-SCHOOL CARE PROGRAM (K-8) begins 8/9/2021

Time: 2:30 p.m. – 5:30 p.m. Monday through Friday

Location: Program starts in Room 217 at 2:30 for Logic School; Program transitions downstairs at 3:00 for Lower School (rotating classrooms monthly)

Purpose: The purpose of the After-School Care Program is to provide a safe and positive place to supervise children who remain on campus after carpool. We are mindful of the reality that these students have been in school all day. We will provide time for homework and fun activities as well as help students build meaningful relationships with peers and counselors.

All students (see list below) who are unsupervised after school must go to the After-School Center.

- The student is not picked up at the regular release/carpool time.
- The student is not with a parent or teacher.
- The student is waiting to participate in an athletic team practice or game, unless they are waiting in the area designated by the coach and are being supervised by a coach, assistant coach, or a parent volunteer.
- The student is waiting to attend an athletic or other after school event. Logic school students may attend these events with permission from the After School Director.
- A younger student is waiting for an older sibling to be released from a high school elective. **Note:** If the student is picked up prior to 3:45, there will not be a charge for the After-School Care Program. After 3:45, an \$8.00 charge will be incurred. **Note:** Younger students may be released to an older sibling who is responsible for driving the student home; otherwise, a parent must pick up the student.
- The student is waiting for any voluntary or optional activity of any kind (e.g. tutoring, study session, drama practice, music lesson).
- Children of on duty CCS staff and children of in season CCS coaches.

PICK-UP: TEXT Mimi Ramos at (919) 534-6201 and your child will be walked out to your car. Please do not text to have your child released until you are at the school.

COST: \$8.00, per student, per day until 5:30 p.m.

- Once a student is checked in to the After-School Center, there will be an \$8.00 charge.
- Note: After 5:30 p.m., the cost will increase to \$1.00 per minute.

BILLING: A daily record of attendance is kept by the After-School Care Program. Families will be billed once a month through the CCS Business Office.

SNACKS: From 3:00-3:30, students may visit quietly, work on homework and have a snack. Please send a snack for your child.

NOTE: Currently Registration is NOT required for the After-School Center or Study Hall. It is operated on a “drop-in” basis.
