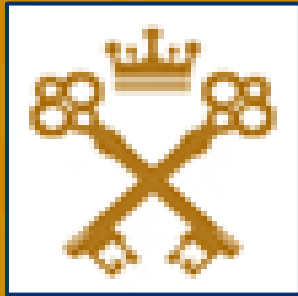
CULTURE

- Please do not text your child during the school day, as often that is the reason they are on their phone.

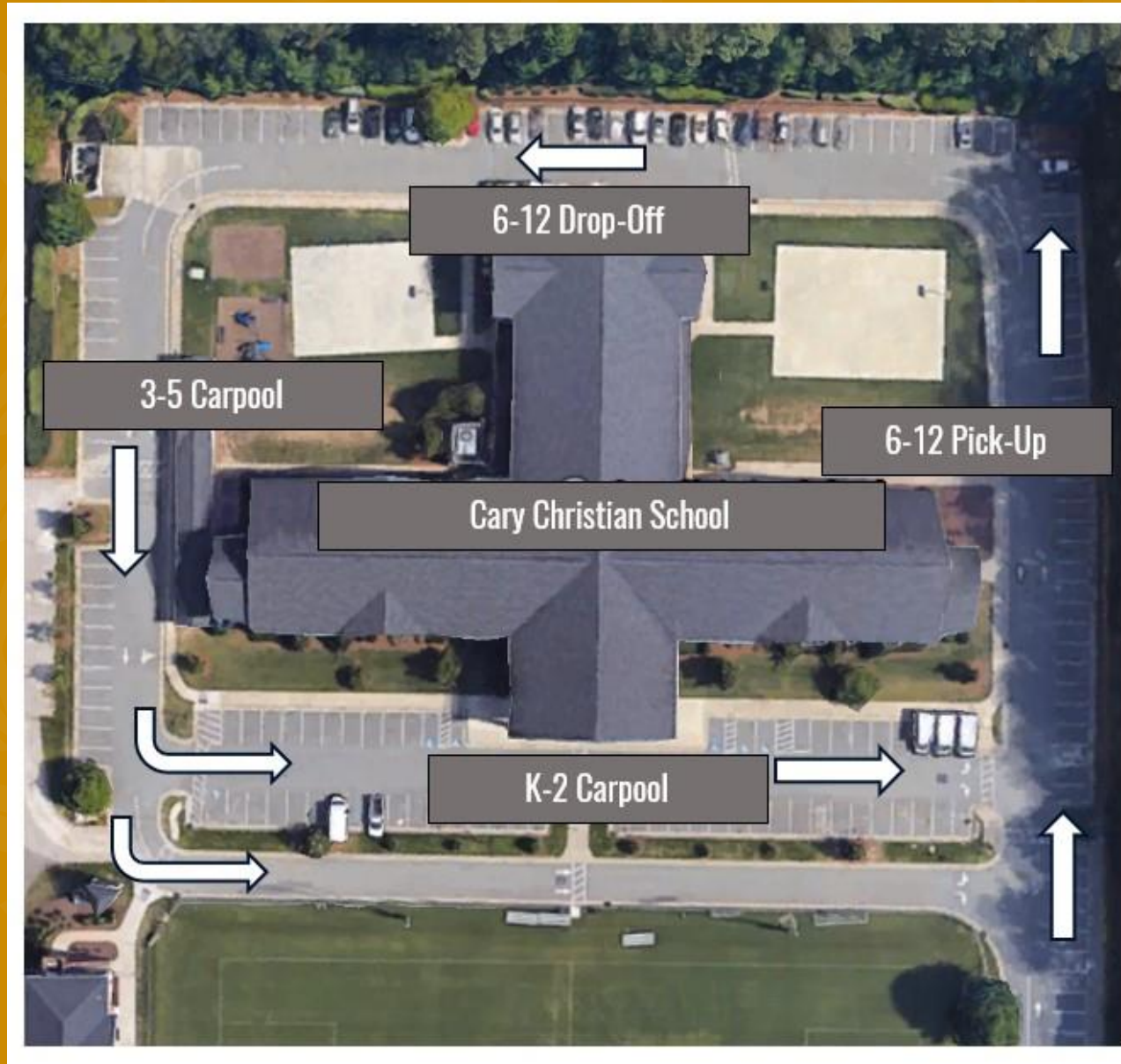
Tardies
