Cary Living, Western Wake County's leading lifestyle magazine, is partnering with *Cary Christian School* for our first ever KALEIDOSCOPE Student Art Contest. The magazine publishes an issue every two months and KALEIDOSCOPE is a regular feature on the back page focused exclusively on art.

Interested *Cary Christian School* students will have until May 1 to create an original work of art inspired by the theme below. Judging will occur during the month of May and the winning piece of art will be our KALEIDOSCOPE feature in the July/August issue of *Cary Living*.

CONTEST THEME

"What is your favorite place in Western Wake County?"

DETAILS

1. The *Cary Living 2022 Student Art Contest* is open to *Cary Christian School* students only, grades 6-12.
2. All artwork must be completed, photographed and turned in by May 1, along with information about the artist and artwork (artist name, age, grade; artwork title, size, medium) and a short, 1-2 sentence artist statement about why and how they chose their subject. Submissions can be turned in either to the *Cary Christian School* art teachers, or submitted directly to *Cary Living* using the online submission form.
3. Students may choose to paint, draw, or sculpt their artwork in any medium they like but should



remember that it will need to look good in a photograph, which is how most people will see it.

4. All entries will be judged by the professional art and design staff from *Cary Living*, and 5 finalists will be chosen. Those works will be presented online where the public can vote on their favorites. All students, teachers, staff, family and friends can vote. The artwork with the most votes wins.
5. The winning piece will be announced by June 1 and the artwork will be featured in the July/August issue of *Cary Living*.
