

**AFTER-SCHOOL CARE PROGRAM

In order to keep our students safe, all CCS K-8 students must be supervised by a parent or designated CCS staff member while anywhere (e.g. classrooms, hallways, lobby, common area, playgrounds, athletic fields) on campus on school days from 7:30 a.m. – 5:15 p.m. **All students not picked up during their designated carpool time (see Parent Student Handbook) must go to the After-School Care Program.**

AFTER-SCHOOL CARE PROGRAM (K-8) August 8, 2022 - May 19, 2023

Time: 2:30 p.m. – 5:15 p.m. Monday through Friday, no care on Early Release Days

Location: Logic School will meet in a classroom on the logic school hallway (rotating classrooms monthly). Program transitions downstairs at 2:45 for Lower School (rotating classrooms monthly)

Purpose: The purpose of the After-School Care Program is to provide a safe and positive place for children who remain on campus after carpool. We are mindful of the reality that these students have been in school all day. We will provide time for homework and fun activities as well as help students build meaningful relationships with peers and counselors.

When should my child attend the After School Program? - Students K-8 who are staying past their carpool time (without other designated adult supervision)

- The student is not picked up at the regular release/carpool time.
- The student is not with a parent or teacher.
- The student is waiting to participate in an athletic team practice or game, unless they are waiting in the area designated by the coach and are being supervised by a coach, assistant coach, or a parent volunteer.
- The student is waiting to attend an athletic or other after school event (ex. Tutoring, study session drama practice, music lesson, etc). Logic school students may leave the program to attend these events with permission from the After School Director and parent.
- A younger student is waiting for an older sibling to be released from a high school elective. Student is considered part of the After School program and the daily charge will apply. **Note:** Younger students may be released to an older sibling who is responsible for driving the student home; otherwise, a parent must pick up the student.
- Children of on duty CCS staff and children of in season CCS coaches.

PICK-UP: TEXT Mimi Ramos at 919-917-8927 and your child will be walked out to your car. Please do not text to have your child released until you are at the school.

COST: \$8.00, per student, per day until 5:15 p.m.

- Once a student is checked in to the After-School Program, there will be an \$8.00 charge.
- Note: After 5:15 p.m., the cost will increase to \$1.00 per minute.

BILLING: A daily record of attendance is kept by the After-School Care Program. Families will be billed once a month through the CCS Business Office.

SNACKS: From 3:00-3:30, students may visit quietly, work on homework and have a snack. Please send a snack for your child.

NOTE: *Currently, Registration is NOT required for the After-School Program as it is operated on a “drop-in” basis.*
