



PSAT/NMSQ FAQ'S

What is the cost of the test?	The cost of the test is \$25 payable through Veracross Pay. A late fee of \$15 will be added after the September 1 deadline.
When is the deadline to register?	The deadline for registering is September 1, 2022.
When should I arrive?	Students must arrive by 8:00 AM. Anyone arriving after 8:00 AM may not be admitted to the exam.
How long is the exam?	Students should be finished with the exam between 11:45 am and 12:15 pm depending on the administration.
What about cellphones, smart watches, and calculators?	Students may not bring cellphones and smart watches into the testing room. They must leave those items in their lockers or their cars. Students may only use approved calculators. Click here PSAT 8/9 Calculator Policy - SAT Suite College Board to access the approved calculators through College Board.
Do I wear my CCS uniform?	No, you may wear modest street clothing.
When are the results available?	Historically, results for the PSAT/NMSQT are available in December.
May Freshmen take this test?	No, Freshmen may not take this test.
