

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT-PURPOSE

Social Exec Team- The Social Exec Team is responsible for leading, planning and implementing social events at CCS. The Social Events currently include Hoedown, Snowball, Homecoming and Christmas activities.

Service Exec Team-The Service Exec Team is responsible for leading, planning, and implementing service opportunities at CCS. The Service opportunities consist of activities with at least one activity per quarter (e.g., interactions between Lower School and Upper School students, Angel Tree, Note writing, Food Drives, etc.)

Worship Exec Team-The Worship Exec Team is responsible for leading, planning and implementing one worship night per quarter.

House Exec Team-The House system provides opportunities for what we call "vertical unity." Rather than the standard categories of grade and age providing an identity, the House encourages younger students to look up to and interact with older students, while the older students are given the opportunity to lead and care for the younger students. All $6^{th} - 12^{th}$ grade students and teachers are assigned to a House. Through the years, students from the same family are assigned to the same House to build and nurture the legacy of community interactions.

House Activities are scheduled for one Friday per quarter (Rhetoric School) and every Friday (Logic School) and are led by the House Leadership and House Advisors. Knigths'Fest is held in the 3rd Quarter.

Communications Team- The Communications Team will work with all Student Leadership Teams and Clubs, with oversight from the Director of Communications, to manage student communications for the *Knightly News*, the Commons Area message board, hallway bulletin boards, and social media posts.
