



Dear Sophomores, Juniors, and Parents,

On Thursday, October 24, all Sophomores and Juniors will take the Digital Adaptive PSAT/NMSQT at Cary Christian School. All Sophomores and Juniors have been registered and the cost has been included in the CCS tuition and fees.

To prepare, students must **download the Bluebook testing application from College Board onto their laptop by Monday, September 30**. Use the link below. The students **must download the Bluebook testing app from College Board** onto his or her personal laptop - a Windows or Mac device or an iPad. Personal Chromebooks are **not** approved by College Board . Students will need to bring their personal laptop to school for the test on October

Once a student does that, the student can get familiar with digital testing, take a practice Digital PSAT, and practice working with the built in Desmos Graphing Calculator. Practicing for the Digital Adaptive PSAT will allow a student to perform well.

If a student has problems downloading Bluebook, here are some trouble shooting tips:

- Turn off or delete VPN.(VPN must be turned off on testing day.)
- Make sure they have the latest update for the required browser or App.
- Clear history/cookies.
- Make sure device is updated.
- Make sure device has been rebooted.

Students must bring their charged laptops with Bluebook downloaded on them to school on **Tuesday, October 1** for the Digital Readiness Check.
